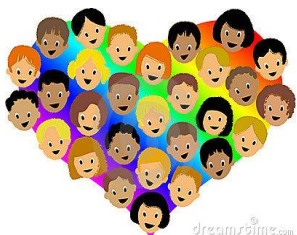

April 20- Status of Women’s Rights Around the World

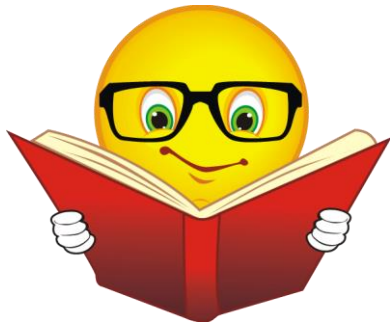
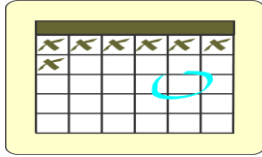
This program will be presented by our very own Anais Trodec and should not be missed.
