The theme for this year's convention is **Women Leaders: Past, Present, Future**. Highlights of the Convention include a Friday Night Movie, **Equity**, at the Coronado Center. Delegates will check in, enjoy a glass of wine and appetizers, and watch a movie about a female investment banker trying to work her way up the Wall Street ladder.

Saturday, we will meet at the Desoto Club where Chef Johnna will provide a continental breakfast and lunch.
