



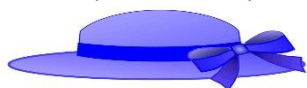

Maria Jones, President of Arkansas AAUW, has AAUW in her blood. She is a Life Member of AAUW, daughter of an Honorary Life Member, granddaughter of a past AAUW Regional Director and State President. Both her daughter and son are members of AAUW!

Maria has served as president of the Little Rock Branch, and has been state president since 2014. Under her guidance, AAUW has increased its influence and formed many new relationships to help meet the mission of our organization.

She retired from the Arkansas Department of Health in November 2015 after 35 years of state service. She is currently working part time in the Office of Administration, and is a partner in Community Resource Innovations, a consulting firm supporting rural communities and school districts as they work to improve education and quality of life through the community schools model.

Maria will be the speaker at our September AAUW meeting, and will inform us about the great work being done by our organization in Arkansas. She will also bring us news
