SANDRA ESCOBAR'S PURSUIT OF CITIZENSHIP -ROBINSON RAFFLE IN APRIL!

For those who didn't attend our February or March meetings, the branch is collecting monies to assist Sandra Escobar with the costs of obtaining her U.S. Citizenship. Sandra is a two time recipient of the AAUW Scholarship funds, and has met all the requirements for attaining citizenship (green card, time in US, etc). She is still in school, driving to Henderson State University every day from Glenwood. The application for citizenship costs \$750.00, an enormous amount of money for her as a full-time student.

Back in January, the Board voted to collect monies at the February, March and April meetings for Sandra. To date we have raised \$340 towards the application costs...not quite half. At the April meeting we will raffle off two tickets to the Arkansas Symphony's Sunday, May 13 performance of Raiders of the Lost Ark to

be held at 3:00 at The Robinson Theater. The tickets are in the upper tier, first row center. Raffle tickets will be \$5.00 each and all proceeds will go towards Sandra's citizenship application costs. For those not wanting to participate in the raffle, you may make a separate donation.
