SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

Our 2022-2023 recipients have entered their spring semester!

Now your scholarship committee is working on the plan for the 2023-2024 academic year. Applications for AAUW scholarships are online at NPC and we will accept them through March 17. Qualified applicants will be interviewed by a team of 5 AAUW scholarship committee members in mid-April. Decisions are made by the end of April and recipients notified by mid-May.

You will recall that the AAUW scholarship is based on need and can be used only for tuition, books and associated fees. Through the fundraising efforts back in the Fall of 2022, along with funds from interest on our endowments at NPC and some “unused” cash in our account at NPC, we will have \$20,000 to award this cycle. As with everything else, costs have gone up and, of course, we want to help as many women as possible. There is no question that our scholarships make a world of difference to those selected!
