The scholarship committee will have \$20,000 to award for the 2023-2024 academic year. Applications were to be received at NPC by March 18 and it appears there are 16 applications for both NPC and transfers to Arkansas universities. Interviews with qualified applicants will take place April 19 and 20 at NPC. The interview team anticipates selecting ten recipients and awarding \$2,000 each, \$1,000 per semester. The full scholarship committee will make the final decisions, with the AAUW board responsible for affirmation of the awards.
